Closing Ceremonies are at [Cuidad de las Artes y las Ciencias](#), the Arts and Science Museum.

[EMERGENCY IN SPAIN](#)

DIAL 1-1-2

If you need emergency services assistance in Spain, dial 1-1-2. Operators in Spain speak English as well as Spanish. If you don't speak Spanish, simply state your emergency in English and the operator will either reply in English themselves, or they will transfer you to an English-speaking operator.

Police in Valencia is organized into three different agencies. Policia Local are the local police agency. Policia National and the Guardia Civil are the other two law enforcement agencies. All may be accessed by using 1-1-2 in an emergency.

PARA MARTIAL ARTISTS

Special Advisor to IAGLMA on Para Martial Arts

Since 1994, Gay Games has seen an increase of Para athletes participating in the Games, including within Martial Arts. HIV/AIDS brought an increasing number of athletes with chronic illnesses who continued training and competing. The number of Para athletes and cultural participants varies from Games to Games due to several different factors. Coming out as LGBTQ+ and being disabled, or becoming a Para athlete, is often a very difficult path, made even more so in the current political world climate. The Federation of Gay Games and IAGLMA is committed to the full inclusion of Para Martial Artists in all ways.

A Para Martial artist is someone who, on the basis of their impairment or chronic illness, is hampered through such on a **permanent basis**. The variety of impairments and chronic illness among Para athletes is enormous therefore IAGLMA recognizes that our rules and regulations must be amended and adjusted and adapted on an on-going basis to fully include Para Martial Artists in all Divisions whenever and wherever possible. We fully commit to this effort.

We are significantly assisted in recognizing, understanding, and implementing these changes and amendments by our **Special Advisor to the IAGLMA Board of Directors on Para Martial Arts, Lydia Zijdel**. Lydia is a vital resource in assisting the IAGLMA Board in all matters related to Para Martial Arts athletes. Through Lydia we have fully adopted Para Martial Artist amendments into our Tournament Rules and will apply the concepts of the [European Union Participation, Recreation and Inclusion through Martial Arts Education \(PRIME\)](#) guidelines.

“My first Gay Games were in New York in 1994,” said Lydia.

“Others in the Martial Arts community may have a longer Gay Games history than I do, but a first experience is often the most memorable. Although this was during the Clinton administration, immigration rules for people with HIV/AIDS were extremely strict. Given founder Tom Waddell’s commitment to openness and inclusion, especially for people with HIV/AIDS, it was a cruel irony that these rules created so many barriers to entry. Travelling discreetly with dear friends living with the disease, being deeply moved by all we experienced at those Gay Games and noticing how few disabled LGBT+ participants were present inspired us to commit to the next Gay Games in Amsterdam.”

“For four years, we worked to build a team that would welcome not only people with HIV/AIDS, but all LGBT+ people with disabilities and/or chronic illnesses, so they could feel safe, secure, and included. As martial artists, we often begin with a sense of invincibility, but overcoming your own limits and creating safe spaces for others is far more fulfilling. Seeing so many Gay Games participants facing multiple challenges—whether physical, sensory, or mental, or simply the danger of coming from countries where being LGBT+ is severely punished—is the greatest reward, the true “medal” one can receive. We experienced that again in Sydney in 2002 and felt even more honoured to receive the Tom Waddell Award in Chicago in 2006.”

“If you are still hesitating about coming to Valencia, a beautiful city with warm and welcoming people, where being yourself as an LGBT+ person is entirely normal, come and meet those from around the world who still face daily challenges, and witness the true essence of Martial Arts: humility, harmony, and mindfulness.”

MARTIAL ARTS WEAPONS IN SPAIN

If you have not already done so, please send us the information listed below if you are planning to bring your martial arts weapons to Spain to participate in Weapons Forms or Self-Defense Divisions. Please email us at IAGLMA.HQ@gmail.com as **soon as possible** with the following information:

1. Your **full name** (as it appears in your passport / travel documents)
2. The **date** and **port of entry** to Spain (airport, border crossing, harbor)
3. The **date** and **port of exit** from Spain (airport, border crossing, harbor)
4. A **full description of all martial arts weapons** you will bring with you. (i.e. Wooden Bokken, Metal and wood Kama, 30" steel live blade (sharp) Katana, etc.)

As we are not a legal entity, and certainly not a Spanish legal authority, we cannot offer formal legal advice or counsel in this regard. We can only offer our best guidance and suggestions as follows:

1. Spain has very strict [weapons controls](#) and many traditional martial arts weapons fall into the controlled category where they are generally not allowed to be imported into Spain or possessed within Spain.
2. If you decide to bring your martial arts weapons to Spain, wrap and package them carefully and securely and check them with your baggage for air travel to Spain.
3. Be sure to have a copy of your **Gay Games Valencia 2026 registration information** to show to immigration officials when you enter Spain.
4. Be sure to have a copy of the [Participants Letter \(EN\)](#) [Participants Letter \(ES\)](#) in both English (EN) and Spanish (ES) which will explain you are a martial artist, participating in the Gay Games Valencia 2026 martial arts tournament in a weapons division, and the weapons are necessary for that performance. This letter will have contact information for the Gay Games Valencia key personnel, and Valencia City key personnel.
5. As immigration officials and processes are different in every country, and subject to local interpretations that may change from time to time, we unfortunately cannot guarantee that any martial arts weapons you bring with you will make it through immigration without confiscation.
6. If you successfully pass immigration with your martial arts weapons, PLEASE ENSURE you continue to conduct yourself in an appropriate, courteous, professional, and respectful manner when transporting the weapons to and from the tournament and when storing them within your hotel, or accommodation in Spain. Carry your **Gay Games registration** and Participants Letter with you at ALL times when transporting your martial arts weapons.
7. **DON'T** remove your weapons from their carrying covers in public, and **DON'T** practice with your weapons in a public space.

WEAPONS FORMS DIVISION CHANGES

WEAPONS FORMS

Recognizing the incredible surge in popularity of the new light-weight carbon fiber weapons that come in a variety of colorful designs and can include digital lights and even sound effects, IAGLMA has adopted two distinct sub-groups within the Weapon's Forms Division.



TRADITIONAL Weapons Forms will include any participants using a recognized traditional martial arts weapon, made from traditional and “typical” materials such as wood, steel, bamboo, rattan, etc. The weight and balance of traditional martial arts weapons require different handling skills and traditional forms developed for such weapons tend to be more skills and techniques focused rather than speed and gymnastic abilities focused.

NON-TRADITIONAL Weapons Forms will allow any weapon that is not recognized as a traditional martial arts weapon, and those weapons which are made from modern light-weight materials. This will include light-weight weapons that resemble traditional martial arts weapons, and those which are not typically recognized as traditional martial arts weapons.



ALL weapons, whether falling into the **TRADITIONAL** or **NON-TRADITIONAL** category **must be kept under the full control of the participant at all times** during their performance. Weapons may be placed carefully on the floor and recovered later, but weapons must not fall from the grip, slip from the grip, or be thrown in a horizontal plane unless restricted under full control by the participant such as with a chain whip, three section staff, nunchaku etc. All weapons **MUST** always remain within the confines of the ring.






The goal of this change is to encourage creativity and engage younger martial artists who are often drawn to the lighter-weight, more dynamic and gymnastic forms of the Xtreme competitions. This also affords the opportunity to consider non-traditional weapons as a demonstration item.

We will decide if two separate Groups are required in Valencia once we have a better understanding of how many Weapons Forms participants we have registered, and once we can determine what weapons each participant will utilize for their form.

DAY #1 MONDAY June 29 – Participants and Officials Clinics

Our first day at Gay Games Valencia Martial Arts Tournament will involve a **MANDATORY Participants Orientation Clinic** and an **Officials Certification Clinic**. Be sure to bring your **Gay Games official ID** to all events at the Velodrome.

MANDATORY Participants Orientation Clinic @ the Velodrome at 10 AM

ALL participants MUST attend this clinic which will quickly cover the IAGLMA Tournament rules and provides an opportunity for participants to ask questions, get to know their fellow martial artists, and perhaps find partners to help with self-defense or team forms divisions. **Failure to attend this clinic will result in you being denied participation in ALL Divisions you have registered for.**

Officials Certification Clinic @ the Velodrome at 12:30 PM (approximately)

Black Belt and equivalent attendees are asked to attend the **Officials Certification Clinic** which normally takes place immediately after the participants Orientation Clinic. This clinic will cover the IAGLMA rules and how the tournament will be organized and run in more detail, with a view to certifying all attendees as IAGLMA qualified tournament officials.

ARBITRATORS – are impartial high-ranking officials who will resolve disputes, protests, or technical rule violations and who define and decide issues regarding tournament rules when uncertainty arises.

REFEREES – control and score sparring matches between two participants by starting and stopping the match, issuing points and deductions, and ensuring the safety of participants throughout the match.

JUDGES – control and score forms and self-defense performances by providing a considered and impartial assessment of each participants performance.

DAY #2 TUESDAY June 30 – Tournament OPENS

Our first tournament day at Gay Games Valencia Martial Arts Tournament is scheduled to include the following participation divisions:

1. **Empty Hand Forms** (open to all)
2. **Weapon's Forms** (open to all)(May be split into Traditional and non-Traditional)
3. **Musical Forms** (open to Black Belt or equivalent rank only)
4. **Two-Person Empty Hand Team Forms** (open to all)
5. **Two-Person Weapon's Forms** (open to all)
6. **Synchronized Team Forms** (open to all – minimum of 3 team members required)

Be sure to bring your **Gay Games official ID** to all events at the Velodrome.

DAY #3 WEDNESDAY July 01 – Tournament CONCLUDES

Our second tournament day at Gay Games Valencia Martial Arts Tournament is scheduled to include the following participation divisions:

7. **Self-Defense** (open to all)
8. **Sparring** under IAGLMA tournament rules (open to all)

VENUE FOR MARTIAL ARTS



The venue for Martial Arts at Gay Games XII – Valencia, Spain is the [Velòdrom Lluís Puig](#), pictured above. This venue is located in **Benimamet**, a neighborhood in the Northwest of the city.

This location will host Martial Arts, Wrestling, Grappling, and Table Tennis. The Velodrome is served by both a tramway and a bus connection to the city center, and is approximately a fifteen to twenty minute drive from the city center.

Wrestling and Grappling will run from Sunday through Tuesday.
Martial arts will run from Monday through Thursday.
Table Tennis will run from Monday through Friday.

The Velodrome will be available on Sunday for practice and getting to know the space. Martial Arts has shared Gay Games venues with the Wrestlers in many past events, and we certainly always get on with our fellow “fighting” arts participants.

The Velodrome also has a cafeteria, vending machines, and some bars around the area for a welcome “pint” after the day’s hard work! The Exhibition Fair of Valencia is also located right next to the Velodrome. We will look forward to welcoming you to the Velodrome in just a few short months now.

One week of martial arts training – Muay Thai, BJJ, silat, strength & conditioning, community and collective self-defense, MMA – and related workshops and activities. There will also be a gala (fighting event) on Friday and a party on Saturday night. Our aim is to practice together and to build solidarity networks.

We will have access to 2 studios, showers, a changing room and a chill space at P.A.R.T.S., a dance school.

QTMA organization team is trans, mostly Caucasian, and from across Western Europe and Turtle Island / North America. We come from different life and martial arts backgrounds.

As martial arts practitioners we know how rare and precious queer and trans training spaces can be. We also know that to approach the mat or ring, is to reckon with trauma and mortality. To fight back is an affirming tool we aspire to share, to empower ourselves, and to subvert the narratives surrounding our bodies.

The cost will be between 150 and 350 Euros for the week, depending on your situation. Registration will prioritize BIPOC and trans people.

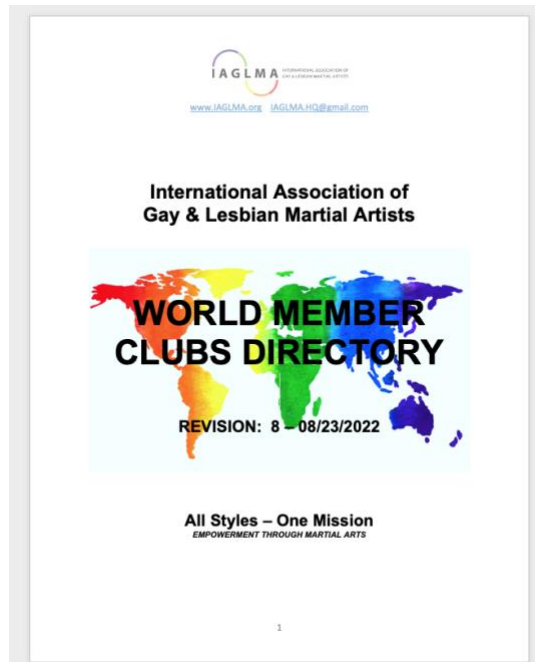








